Rolex China Sea Race 2023

Notice to Competitors #2

The Rolex China Sea Race 2023 Sailing Instructions (SIs) are amended as follows:

1. **8. COURSE**

Delete “**Tan Kan Shan (Danyan Dao)**” and replace with “**Tan Kan Shan (Dangan Dao)**”.

2. **10. MARKS**

Delete SI 10.2 & SI 10.3 and replace with:

10.2 For a club line start, the Outer Distance Mark (ODM) will be a **white inflatable Rolex branded buoy** laid roughly to the north of the RHKYC Kellett Island clubhouse. The Inner Distance Mark (IDM) will be an orange inflatable buoy.

10.3 For a committee vessel start, the starting marks will be the race committee signal vessel at the starboard end of the line and a **white inflatable Rolex branded buoy** at the port end.

3. **13. THE FINISH**

Delete SI 13.1 and replace with:

13.1 The finishing line will be in the vicinity of Latitude N14° 46.6', Longitude E120° 13.2' to the northwest of Grande Island at the entrance to Subic Bay. The finishing marks will be a race committee vessel at the starboard end of the line and red channel buoy No. 6 at the port end. The finish vessel may display a **white flashing light at night**.
