



## WORLD SAILING, KEEL & RUDDER CHECKS – SURVEYORS OFFERING INSPECTIONS

Under World Sailing, Offshore Special Regulations there is a requirement under Para 3.02.2, 3 & 4 to undertake keel and rudder inspections every 24 months or after a grounding. Below is a list of surveyors who have confirmed they are willing to undertake the inspection. The RHKYC has not verified if the surveyors listed below are a “qualified person” to undertake the required inspection and takes on no liability for their work. Due to the varying design of yachts that can be inspected, it is the responsibility of the yacht owner to determine if the employed surveyor is qualified to undertake the work.
